“RELENTLESS CONSISTENCY” ~ Philippians 4:13

To build success in sports and in life, it takes Relentless Consistency! To be relentless is to be unyielding, persistent, and unrelenting. Someone who is determined, continues in a vigorous or severe matter without pause interruption or mercy. Consistency is the achievement of a level of performance that does not vary greatly in quality over time. Combined they lead to amazing results. Let's look a little closer at Relentless Consistency.

1. OUR RELENTLESS CONSISTENCY CAUSES US TO ATTACK ADVERSITY

Bring it on! That should be our attitude towards attacking adversity. James 1:2 says, *“Consider it pure JOY, whenever you face trials...”* Adversity builds our grit, toughness, perseverance, and confidence! When we attack adversity, we define it as a character builder. “95% of people will give up when things get hard. The 5% who keep pushing, they are the ones who succeed. Be the 5%!!”
